



GUIDELINES FOR PLAY IN THE END-OF-SEASON TOURNAMENTS

- Match results (i.e. Topsail Win 142-12, scoresheet not required) to be sent to Director for documentation.
- Matches shall end as soon as one team achieves an insurmountable score (i.e., 13 points in an NCLC match).
- Quarterfinals matches are to begin promptly at **12:00 noon**. Semifinals matches shall begin no later than **5:00 p.m.**, unless one of the pertinent quarterfinals matches is still in progress. If both teams participating in a semifinals match finish their quarterfinals before 5, they may start early, but only if both teams agree to the early starting time.
- Finals start at 1pm Sunday.**
- Only players on the "eligible player" lists may play in the tournaments. *Eligible Players marked with a "green check mark" on page 2 in newsletter or any player with 4 or more matches.
- "Old" ADO rules for coin tosses/diddling still apply. Only if BOTH teams agree, team captains can choose to toss a coin prior to start of the match to determine the coin toss winner for games during that one match. Same diddle rules apply and will be done for all games based on team flip results.
- REMEMBER: If a team is short-handed, they are simply short-handed. They do NOT get to list a player for a second time in any set, whether it is for a point or as a blocker. Short-handed teams forfeit singles points, and play short in multi-player games.
- In the event of a tie, a team match (6 players) of 1001 FIDO - will be played to determine the winner of the match (no points – please indicate the winner of the match)
- Reminder - High in / out is ONLY for singles 301 games.
